

*Figgie International Headquarters—Glen Allen, Virginia*



The headquarters for Figgie International in Glen Allen, Virginia was constructed by Evans Construction, Inc. The building was called Jefferson Hall, a replica of the Jefferson Hall in Williamsburg, Virginia. It too was magnificent in architectural woodwork, doors made of Philippine mahogany, rooms with 10 and 12 member crown molding, all interior walls were lath and plaster, and a black walnut spiral staircase. This project included a brick covered walkway that would take you from Jefferson Hall to Rawlings Hall. In addition, under this walkway was a covered tunnel so that you could commute from one building to the other without exposure to the weather conditions. The total project was +/- 36,000 sf.
