

*Lebanon United Methodist Church — Mechanicsville, Virginia*

The Lebanon United Methodist Church in Mechanicsville, Virginia project consisted of new 300 seat worship center, and Sunday school classrooms. The total project consisted of a 8,500 square foot addition onto the existing Church. This project was challenging to tie the new structure into a 1700 all wood heart pine siding building, without taking away from the character of the architecture. When using the design build approach, the team can table many different types of construction, review them and make a selection knowing cost and how it fit's to the Church's budget, giving the Church options to consider.
